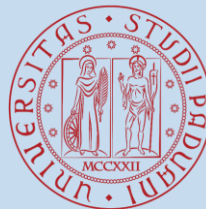

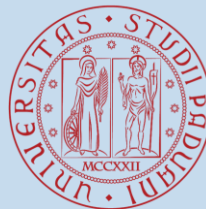

- ▶ But there are many versions of masculinity: this is a crisis of traditional masculinity
- ▶ And an intersectional crisis, where multiples axes of social inequality, based on gender, ethnicity (or how people are racialised/minoritized), social class, disability, sexual preference and identity and age combine
- ▶ 'No climate justice without gender justice' was the rallying cry at COP13 in Bali, 2007

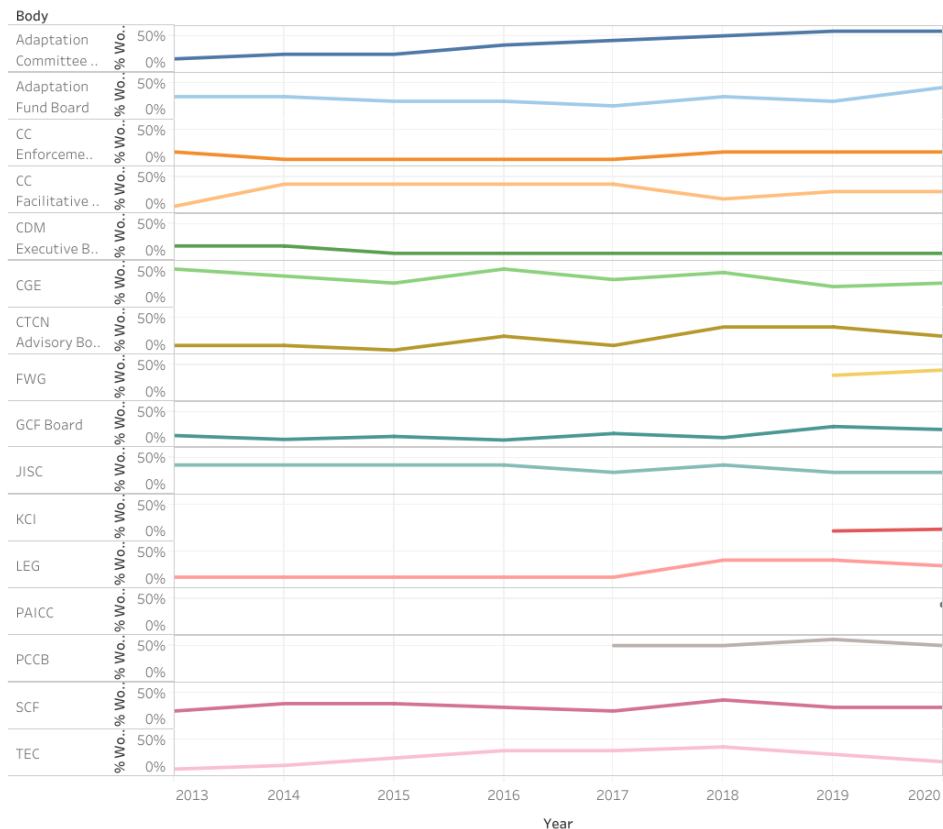

Percentage of Women Members

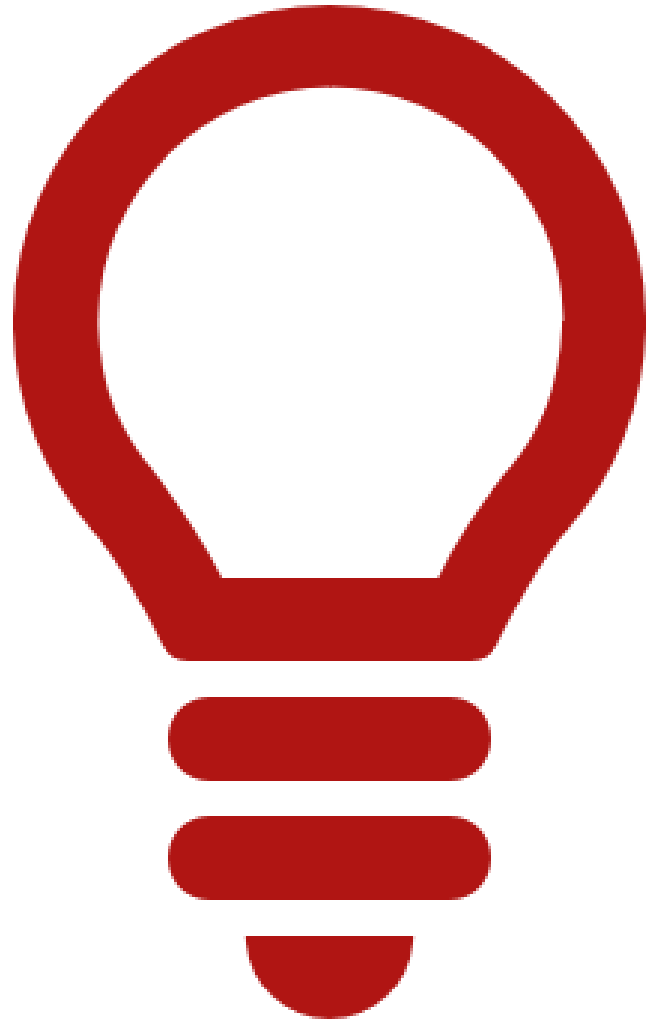

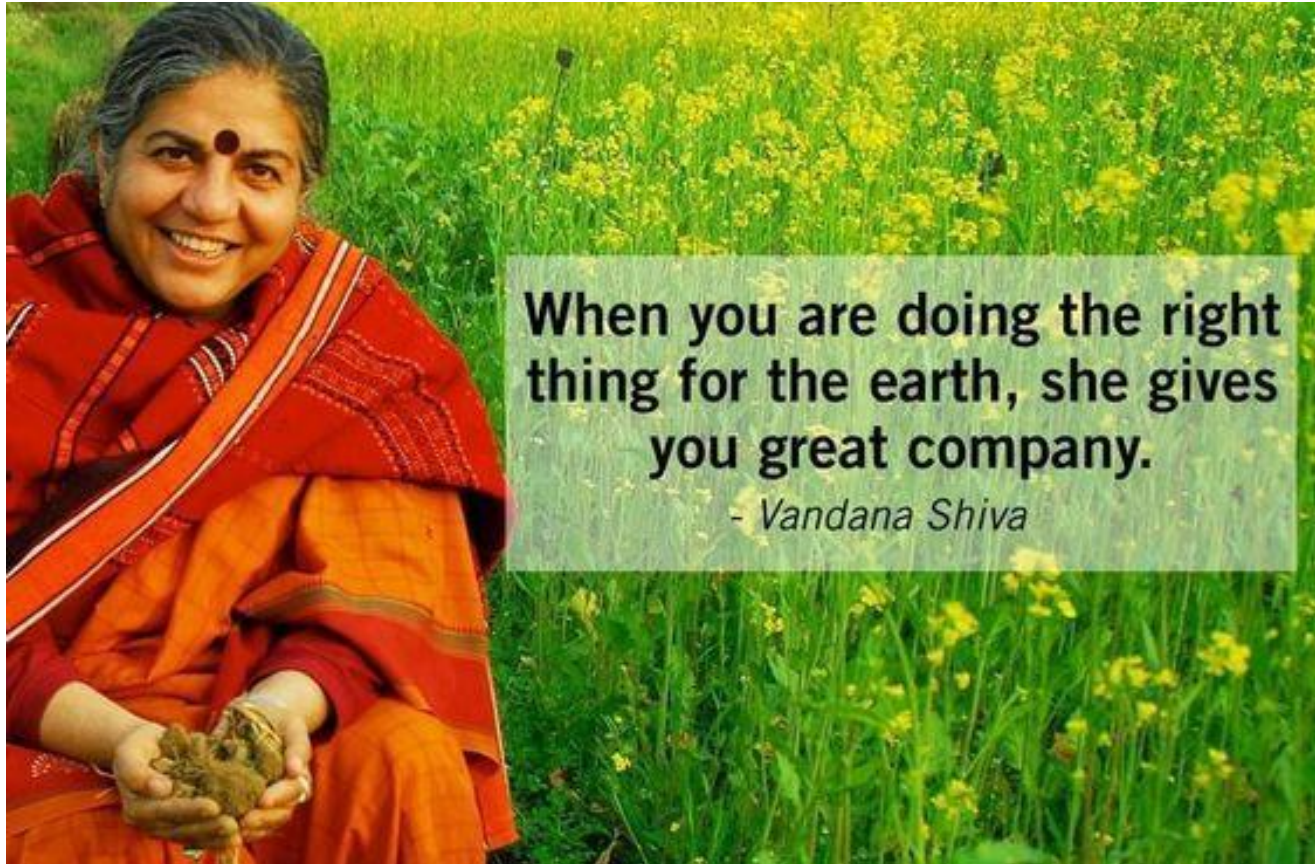
